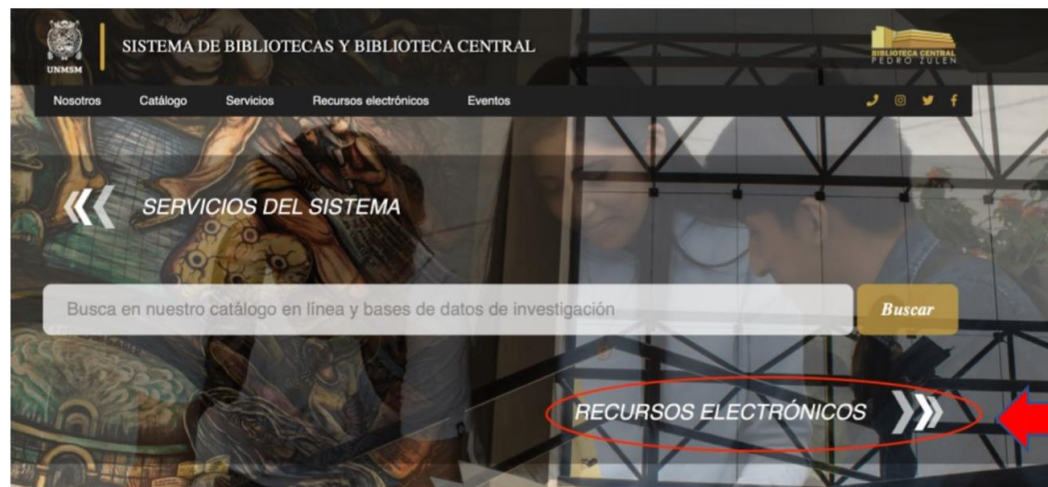

- Las publicaciones más relevantes sobre un tema en específico (en distintos formatos)
- Las publicaciones más citadas sobre un tema.
- El año en que se publicó el primer documento sobre ese tema.
- Las fechas/ años en los que se produjeron más publicaciones sobre un tema específico.
- La/los autores más relevantes sobre un tema en particular.
- El índice H del autor (indicador de calidad en función de la cantidad de veces que ha sido citado)
- La universidad/ institución que más ha publicado sobre un tema en particular
- Los organismos que financian más investigaciones sobre ese tema.
- Las revistas arbitradas que más han publicado sobre el tema o que están dentro de la plataforma (y su posición en la misma – *percentiles*)

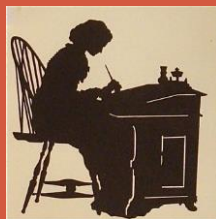

While we find the null effects of implicit versus explicit anti-black and anti-immigrant appeals are partly driven by tolerance for the explicit appeals, we also find evidence that white Americans are adept at recognizing the racial content of appeals featuring widely used, congruent issue-group pairs. 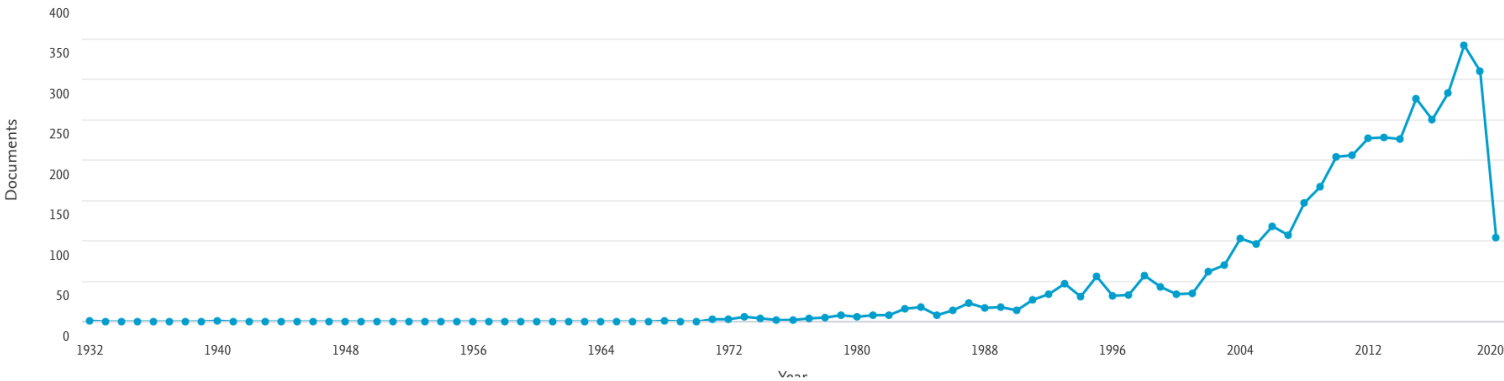
